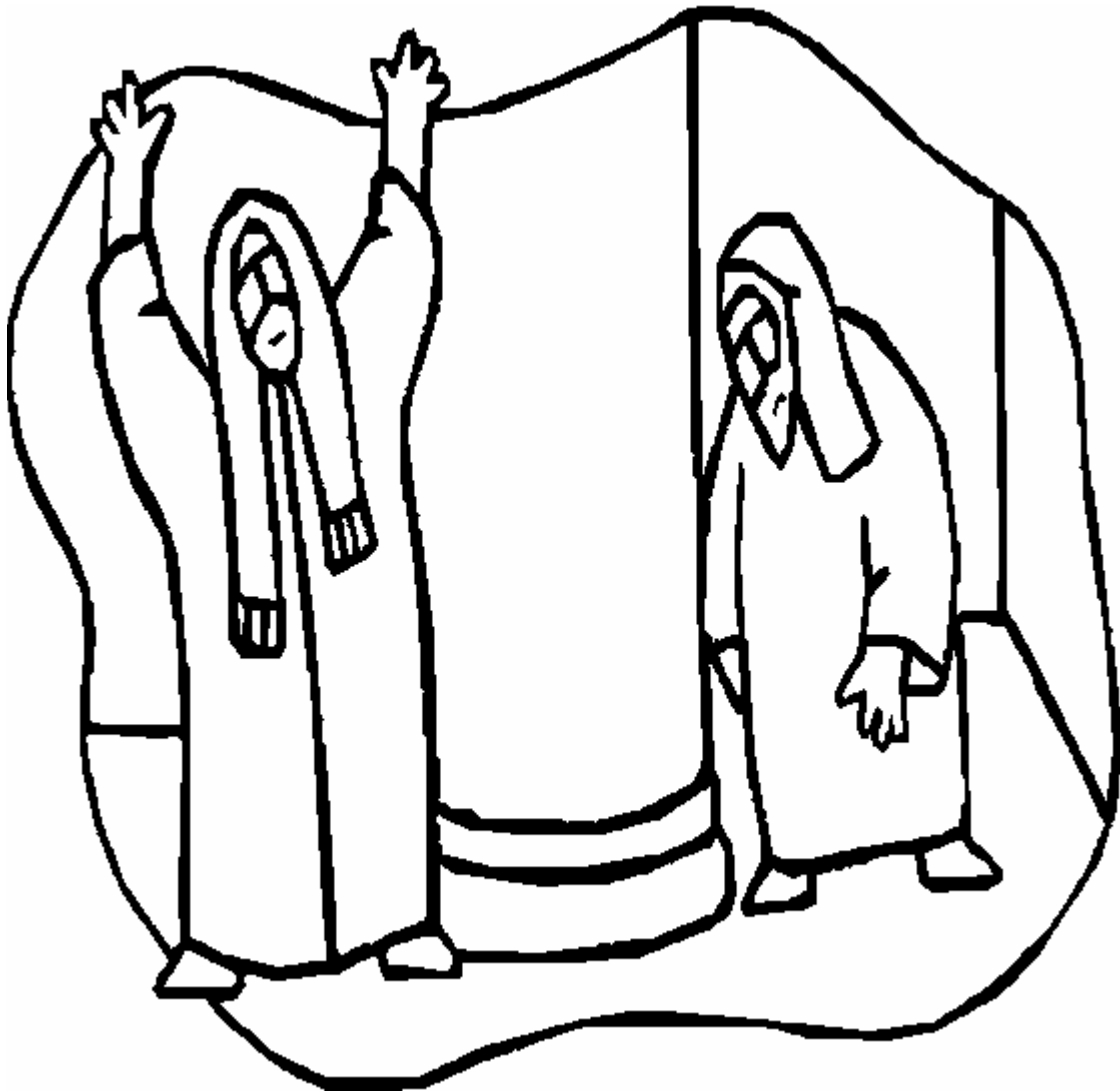


Sunday, October 24, 2004 – 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time
