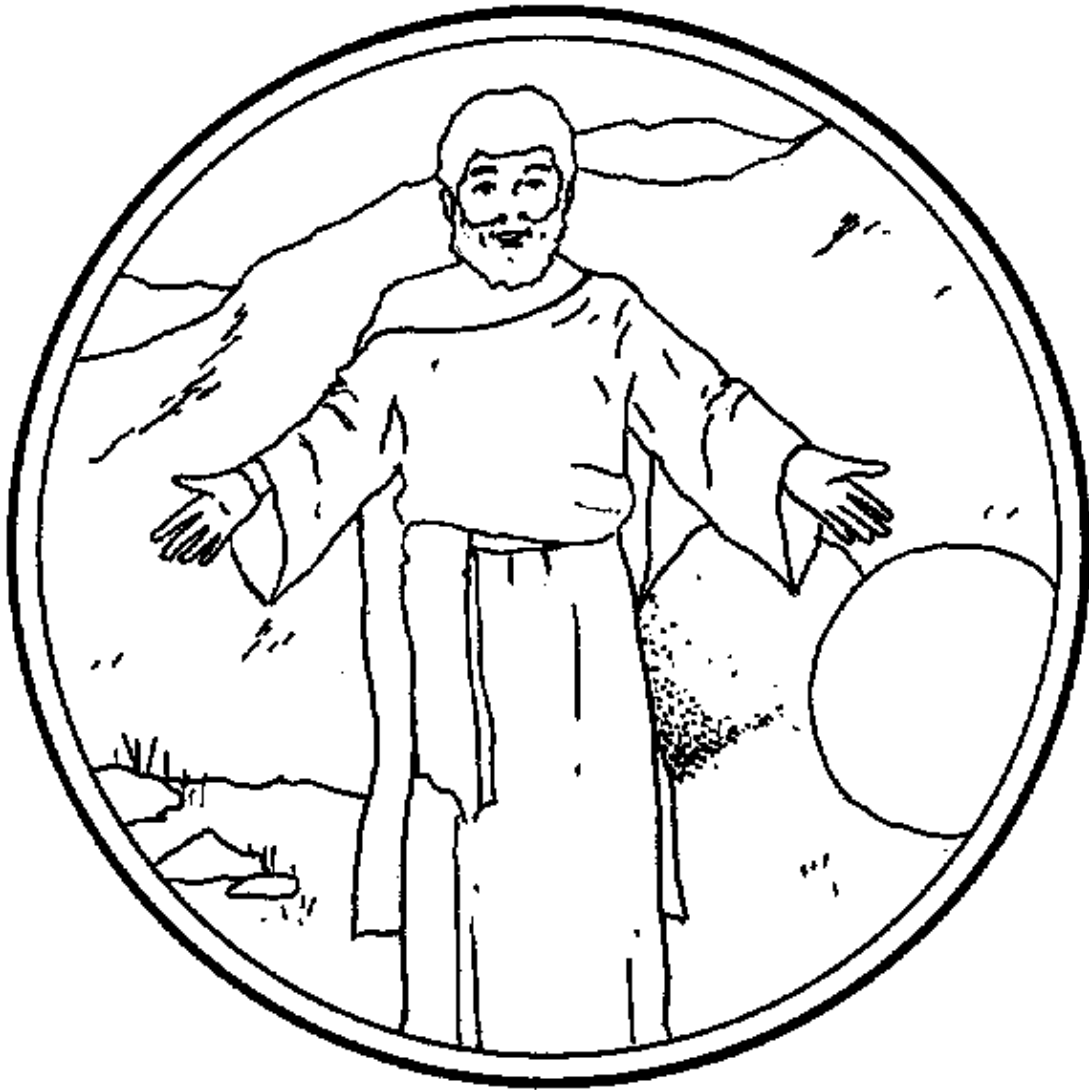


Sunday, November 14, 2004 – 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time
