

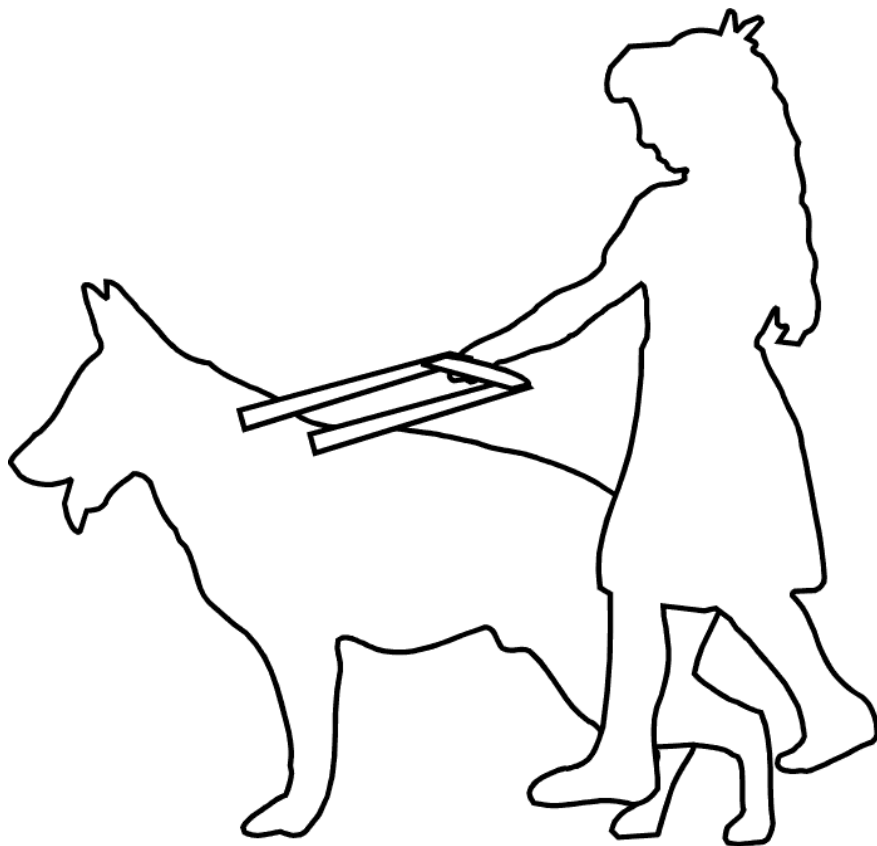

being able to see correctly. You may see a blind person using a cane or being helped by a special dog assistant. Jesus healed the man who had been born blind, and called him to believe that He was the "Son of Man". Jesus wants you and me to believe in Him also, and through our belief in Him we are called to be a "light" to others. Jesus wants us to help the poor, pray for the sick, do acts of loving kindness for others, and speak to Him often in prayer. We learn more about Jesus each week by reading the Gospels, the "good news" about His love for each of us. This week, let us all pray for a strengthening in our belief and let's be a "light"
