Worksheet for ages 11 to 14 years old

1. What day is it, today, in the Catholic Church's calendar?
2. The Catholic Church's calendar has different seasons or "times". They are Lent, Easter, Ordinary, Advent and Christmas. Which season or time are we in, now?
3. What book of the Bible is the first reading from?

Is this book from the Old or New Testament? (Hint: It was written about 100 years before Christ was born.)

Did you know this book is not in Protestant Bibles? It's only in Catholic editions. Bible scholars aren't quite sure who actually wrote this, but he was definitely very smart and knew the scriptures well. In this reading, the author is strongly recommending that we seek what?

4. In your own words, what is the theme of the Responsorial Psalm?
5. Which book is the second reading from?

The people Paul is writing to are a bit worried about something. Can you tell from the first two lines what it is that's confusing them?

6. Which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading from, today?

In this reading, Jesus is explaining in simple terms what the Kingdom of Heaven is like. Who do you think the bridegroom represents?

What do you think is one major lesson from this story?

7. Just before Communion, the priest says, "This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Happy are those who are called to His supper." Did you respond with everyone, loud and clear, "Lord, I am not worthy to receive You, but only say the word and I shall be healed."?
