1. What day is it, today, in the Catholic Church's calendar?
2. What book of the Bible is the first reading from?

Jesus and His Apostles often quoted directly from this book. It's full of excellent advice for life. This reading focuses on the qualities that define a good what?

If so much of this book is dedicated just to this topic, do you think it's something that God considers important?

3. In your own words, what is the theme of the Responsorial Psalm?
4. Did you know the Church considers the Bible the "inspired word of God"? What do you think that means?
5. Which book is the second reading from?
6. Which book of the Bible is the Gospel reading from, today?

In this reading, Jesus is explaining how God expects us to make good use what He gives us, whether it's wealth, creativity, athletic ability, etc. What is one "treasure" that God has given you that you should use for His glory?

7. Just after the Nicene Creed, we say the "Prayer of the Faithful", when we pray for the Church, the world, and our community. What is one thing that your congregation prayed for today?
8. Just before Communion, the priest says, "This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Happy are those who are called to His supper." Did you respond with everyone, loud and clear, "Lord, I am not worthy to receive You, but only say the word and I shall be healed."?
